Our youth instructor, Nick Frasco has experience teaching successfully to students with ASD. They will be assisted by our certified Special Education teacher, Amy Lewis Morgan. This pilot program will have a small student-to-teacher ratio.

This class will explore artistic expression through different artistic mediums beginning with drawing. There will be 15 minute low stress transition period before and after the lesson. Outside breaks will be supervised. All materials are covered in this program.
