Announces Two New Scholarships for the 2021 Summer Youth Program

A local Arts Supporter has come forward to offer two new scholarships for this year's Summer Youth Program which runs from June 21 to July 23. How it works.

Beginning Sunday, May 30, interested students are asked to digitally submit two original artwork pieces, and a 100 word statement describing their interest in art endeavors. Student's parents or guardians are also asked to submit a 100 word statement on why this scholarship is important. The deadline is June 11, 2021 at 6pm.

Recipients will be selected by the Academy Board of Directors based on the student's artistic creativity/skills and the compositions of the statements. Eligible ages: 7 -16 years old. Those who submitted entries will be notified of the Board's decision by June 14. The two scholarship recipients will be featured along with their artwork on the Academy's website with their permission. Scholarship recipients will also receive a \$25. one year student membership to the Academy.

How to enter.

- 1) Entries must be received by Friday, June 11, 2021, 6pm.
- 2) Entries with all info to be included in one email to info@wethersfieldarts.org. Please write "Scholarship Entry" in subject line.
- 3) Attach two (2) original works by the student, in either .pdf or .jpeg format.
- 4) Attach student statement
- 5) Attach parent/guardian statement
- 6) In the body of the email, please provide:
 - A) the name/age of the student
 - B) parent name(s), address, phone, email
 - C) permission to publicize student scholarship winning

Scholarship recipients will be notified via preferred method of contact. Recipients must select their class from offerings made in the 2021 summer program that have capacity as of June 15. Send questions via email to info@wethersfieldarts.org. Best of luck!
