



Building Watercolor Confidence *with* ***Jeremiah Patterson***

Suggested Materials

- ❖ Two 22" X 30" sheets of Arches Cold Pressed 140 lb watercolor paper with a 12" X 16 smooth drawing board **OR** an 11" X 14" Arches Cold Pressed watercolor block.
- ❖ One roll of 3-M Blue Painter's Tape.
- ❖ One pencil, sharpener and white plastic eraser.
- ❖ One Kolinsky Sable Size #6 pointed round brush. Jeremiah highly recommends the Raphael series #8404. If Kolinsky Sable brushes are not available, Jeremiah also recommends the KingArt PREMIUM Finesse # 8020, size #8.
- ❖ A plastic or porcelain round rosette palette, 2 water containers, and some small mixing dishes.
- ❖ A set of watercolor pigments (tube colors are preferred), in a variety of colors. Bring any you have in addition to what is listed below.

Jeremiah recommends a set that includes or is at least supplemented with the following 7 pigments:

Yellow Ochre
Cadmium Yellow light
Cadmium Red Medium
Permanent Rose (quinacridone)
Ultramarine Blue
Windsor Blue (green shade), or Pthalo Blue (green shade)
Sap Green
